DEAN'S LETTER

Summer is fast becoming a memory. Many of our members have attended conferences, traveled to vacation spots, or just lounged around with family and friends. Like most of you, I spent time vacationing with family. And although I enjoy being with them, I am soooo glad to be home in my own bed and now looking forward to seeing my AGO cohorts!

Our 2013-2014 year will kick off on MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 9 with a clergy/musician dinner at Westminster Presbyterian Church in Nashville. Clergy are always welcome at our chapter events but especially at this particular meeting. I encourage each of you to invite your clergy person to attend dinner and the program following as guests of our chapter. Yes, I did say as our chapter's guests. Dinner for clergy will be covered by our chapter, and we are setting a goal of at least 20 clergy. If you've not already reserved a date with your priest or pastor, do so now. Fostering a collegial relationship with pastoral leadership is one of the most important aspects of a successful music ministry.

Dr. Mary Louise Bringle, Professor of Philosophy and Religious Studies at Brevard College, has crafted an inspiring service following our September dinner featuring the WPC Choir, directed by John Semingson and accompanied by Polly Brecht. Dr. Bringle is familiar to many of us as the chair of the hymnal committee of the soon-to-be published, "Glory to God." She is also a hymn writer and former President of the Hymn Society in the US and Canada. The liturgy, reflections, and music of the service will stimulate, energize, and inspire both clergy and musician as we begin our year together.

Also mark your calendars now for the September 30 (our October meeting) hymn festival with John Walker at Downtown Presbyterian Church. The hymn festival is part of a weekend of events celebrating the 100th anniversary of the organ at DPC. Dr. Walker will also present organ recitals on Friday, September 27 and Sunday, September 29. Our chapter will co-sponsor the hymn festival on Monday, September 30 as the final event of the celebration.

At our recent executive board meeting we noted that due to our sizeable membership, we don't know many of our own members. We are a friendly chapter, but sometimes we can't always place a name with a face. So our hospitality chair, Rocky Craft, has suggested some steps we might all observe:

- 1) name tags which include the church and town where members are employed, which should help us with opening a conversation.
- wearing name tags through the end of the program. This will help visitors attending only the program know who we are and also give more visibility to our chapter.
- 3) table hosts to introduce everyone to each other. These are all great suggestions requiring the aid of volunteers as hosts and name tag collectors. Please respond with a "YES, I WILL HELP" when called upon.

Another item the board discussed in relation to our large geographical area, was reaching out to organists in communities outside of the Nashville metro area. We talked about sponsoring satellite organ workshops (SOW) in outlying areas that AGO members could organize involving non-members—the goal being to give more visibility to the work of the AGO and also share organ topics in a smaller (dean's letter continued on page 2)
