VINCENT DUBOIS: LECTURE/RECITAL

The French Symphonic, Neo-classical and Modern Musical Language used in Improvisation

Born in 1980, Vincent Dubois is one of the finest young concert organists to appear on the world stage in many years. He is a graduate of the Conservatoire National Supérieur de Musique in Paris where he was a student



of Olivier Latry, and earned First Prizes in Organ, Harmony, Counterpoint, Fugue and 20th century composition. In 2002 Mr. Dubois won two major organ competitions which launched his worldwide concert career: the Calgary International Organ Competition and the International Competition of Toulouse, France.

Vincent Dubois is the newly-appointed General Director of the Strasbourg National and Superior Conservatory in France, and is also the titular organist at the Cathedral of Soissons, Soissons, France, a position he has held since 2001.

Vincent has made three appearances in Nashville, most recently a solo concert at the Schermerhorn Symphony Center.

This month's meeting does not include dinner; refreshments will follow the program in the lobby.
