

Once the frame of the organ is assembled, your team can install the keyboard. But, before it is ready to install, you will need to get it in order.

1. What you will need:



- 24 Keys
- 1 Keyboard Retainer (rail with some suede)
- Tray (optional)

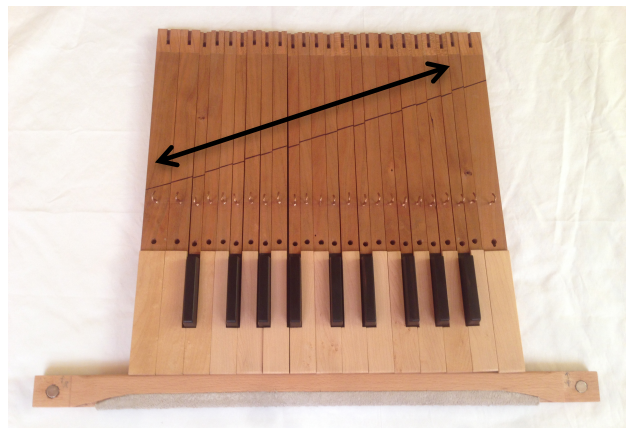
2. How to proceed:



- Arrange all of the keys in the same orientation (facing the same way)
- Place the keys in the correct order. The diagonal line across them will help.
- Use either the tray or the retainer to help line up your keyboard

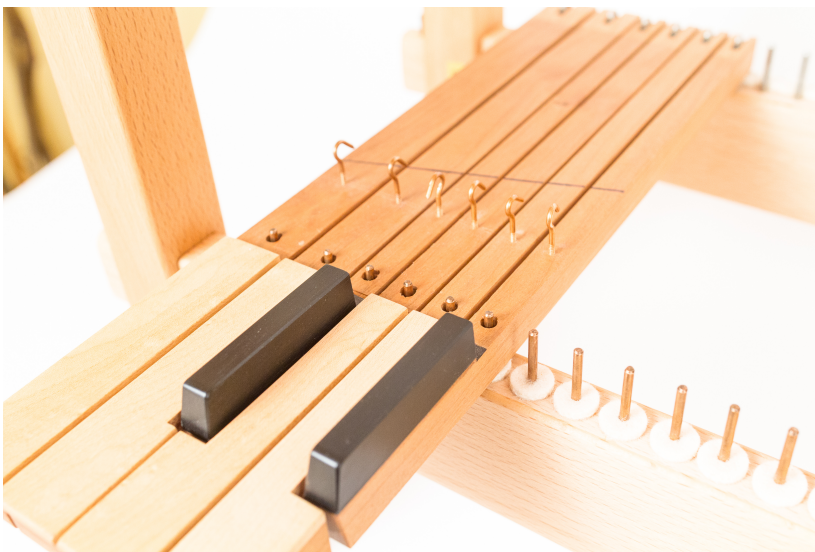
- **Look at the keyboard you have assembled**

- How is this keyboard similar to a piano keyboard?
- How is it different?
- What is it missing?
- Why might that be?

Once the frame of the organ is assembled, you can start installing the keys. Ask the Frame Team to orient you to the frame (Which side is the front?)



- Using both hands, install each key by inserting the BACK of the key on the back PIVOT PINS first. Hold the key at an angle.



- Once the back of the key is seated on the pivot pin, lower the front of the key onto the GUIDE PINS.



Important Final Step!

- Once all of the keys are in the organ, secure them with the KEYBOARD RETAINER. The leather side faces down against the keys.
